

1. Name the different kinds of forests found in India. Explain any two.

Ans- There are five different kinds of forests found in India. Evergreen Forests, Deciduous Forests, Desert Forest, Tidal Forest and Coniferous Forest.

- *Evergreen Forest-These forests remain green throughout the year as all trees do not shed leaves at the same time.
- *Deciduous Forests- In these forests, trees shed their leaves annually. These forests are also known as monsoon forests.
- *Desert Forests- The trees of these forests are scattered, short and thorny. These are known as thorn forests.
- *Tidal Forests- The trees of these forests can survive in fresh as well as salty water of the sea. Due to marshy land, the roots of the trees tend to come out of the surface.
- *Coniferous Forests- These forests are covered with tall, cone-shaped trees which have needle -like leaves.

2. Write four uses of forests.

Ans- Forests are an important and essential natural resource as they provide us with many useful things.

- *They provide us with nuts, berries and fruits.
 - * They provide shelter to wildlife and fodder to animals.
- * They provide us with hard wood and soft wood which is used for making furniture. Paper, plywood and matchsticks are some other useful things.
- * They also provide us medicinal plants and herbs.
- 3. Explain the wild life of the Western Desert.

Ans- The Thar Desert is home to several species of reptiles. Animals like the Blackbuck, Indian wild ass and the Indian gazelle are found here. The desert is also home to a large number of birds like peacock, Great Indian Bustard and Spotted flycatcher. Many desert animals have light coloured fur, which helps to keep them cool.

4. What are the handicrafts and wooden crafts of Rajasthan? Explain.

Ans- The handicrafts of Rajasthan are popular all over the country. Bangles and mirrors made of lacquer and jewellery made of bone, horn and silver are also popular. Wooden crafts like jharokhas, furniture, jewellery boxes and other decorative items are very popular. The bandhani or tie and dye textile of Rajasthan is also famous all over the country.

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
