Ans: Tint- Add white to a colour to create a lighter/ tint colour.

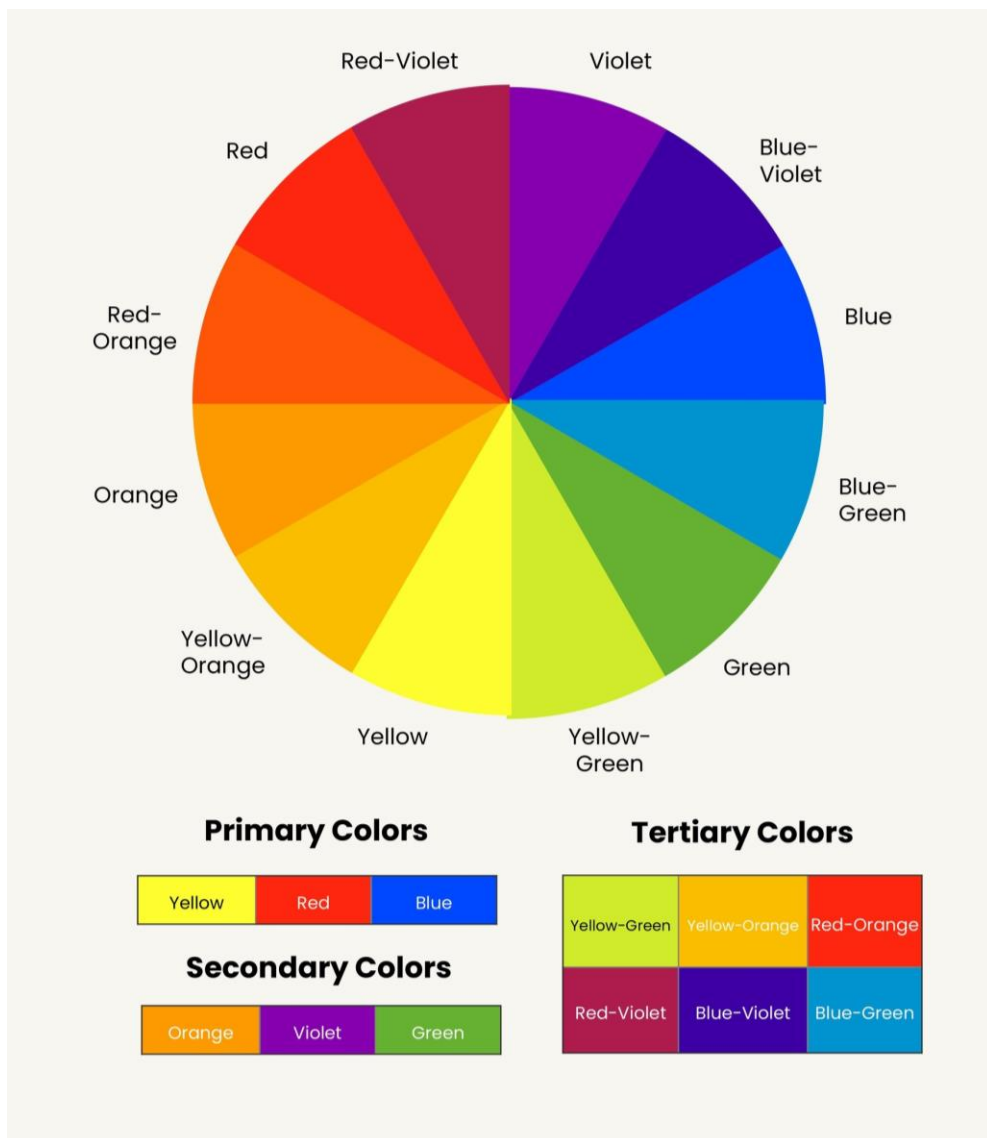
Example- Pink is a tint of red, light blue is a tint of blue.
