Difference = 27,000

12. Estimate by rounding off to nearest thousand:

a. $9,453 - 3,567$

Round:

$3,567 \rightarrow 4,000$

$9,000 - 4,000 = 5,000$

b. $7,845 + 1,245$

Round:

$$7,845 \rightarrow 8,000$$

$$1,245 \rightarrow 1,000$$

$$8,000 + 1,000 = 9,000$$

How many items are there now?

$$\text{New items} = 2,34,567$$

$$\text{Total items} = 5,80,245$$
