 Answer: **Accessibility from Anywhere:**
 Web-based applications can be accessed using a web browser from any device with an internet connection. This allows users to work or access services from any location.
No Installation Required:
 Users do not need to install software on their computers. This saves time, storage space, and ensures easy updates directly on the server.

 Answer: The **Cloud** refers to a system of storing and accessing data and programs over the internet instead of using a local computer or hard drive. It allows users to store files, run applications, and access services anytime, from anywhere using the internet.

 Answer: E-Governance (Electronic Governance) refers to the use of information and communication technology (ICT), especially the internet, by the government to deliver services and information to citizens, businesses, and other government agencies in a fast, efficient, and transparent manner.

 Answer: Stress is the body's physical and emotional reaction to a challenging or demanding situation. It is how we respond when we feel under pressure, anxious, or overwhelmed.

 Answer: Self-Motivation is the ability to encourage yourself to take action and keep going toward your goals without needing pressure or rewards from others. It comes from within and helps you stay focused, confident, and positive.
- 17 What is Goal Setting? 2
 Answer: Goal Setting is the process of identifying something you want to achieve and planning steps to reach it. It helps you stay focused, motivated, and organized in working toward your personal or professional objectives.
- 18 How does the Count () Function works? 2
 Answer: The COUNT() function in spreadsheet applications like OpenOffice Calc or MS Excel is used to count the number of numeric (number) values in a range of cells.
- 19 Define a) Active Cell b) Range of cell
 Answer: An **Active Cell** is the currently selected cell in a spreadsheet. It is the cell where data will be entered or edited, and it is usually highlighted with a bold border.
 A **Range of Cells** is a group or block of selected cells in a spreadsheet. It is usually written using the addresses of the first and last cells, separated by a colon (:).
- 20 Write the steps to protect the spreadsheet.
 Answer: Click on the Tools menu in the top menu bar.
 Select Protect Sheet from the drop-down menu.
 A dialog box will appear. You can:
 Choose to set a password (optional) to prevent others from unprotecting the sheet.
 If you do not set a password, the sheet will still be protected, but it can be unprotected easily.
 Click OK.

- 21 Write the three precautions that you must take while performing online transactions. 3
 Answer:
 Use Secure Websites: Always ensure the website URL starts with https:// and has a lock icon in the address bar before entering personal or payment details.
 Do Not Share OTP or Password: Never share your One-Time Password (OTP), PIN, or password with anyone, even if they claim to be from a bank.
 Use Strong and Unique Passwords: Create strong passwords using a mix of letters, numbers, and special characters. Avoid using the same password on multiple websites.

22 Differentiate between Development and Deployment.

Answer:

Development	Deployment
It is the process of creating and building a software or web-based application.	It is the process of making the developed application available for use.
Involves writing code, designing features, and testing during creation.	Involves installing, configuring, and launching the application on a server or platform.
Done by developers/programmers .	Done by system administrators or DevOps teams .
Example: Writing code for an online shopping website.	Example: Uploading the website to a live server for public access.

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Answer:

1. ##### (Hash Symbols)

This appears when the column is too narrow to display the entire content or number.

2. #DIV/0!

This error occurs when a number is divided by zero or an empty cell.

3. #VALUE!

This error occurs when the formula has the wrong type of data, such as trying to perform arithmetic on text.
