Answer - Kharif crops are those that are planted at the beginning of the monsoon season, typically from June to July, and harvested in the autumn, usually from September to October.

11. Why is the Indian Ocean named after our country? Give three reasons.

Answer- The Indian Ocean is named after India because:

- (i) India has the longest coastline on the Indian Ocean.
- (ii) India has a central location between East and West Asia.
- (iii) India's southernmost extension, the Deccan Peninsula, protrudes into the Indian Ocean, making it significant for international trade conducted through the Indian Ocean.

Ans. 1) The four factors of production are land, labour, capital, and entrepreneurship. Land encompasses all-natural resources used in production. Labour refers to the human effort, both physical and mental, used in production. Capital includes man-made resources like machinery, buildings, and tools. Entrepreneurship involves the skills and initiative to organize and manage the other factors to produce goods and services.

OR

In Indian agriculture, capital is arranged differently by small, medium, and large farmers. Small farmers often rely on borrowing from moneylenders or traders, sometimes at high interest rates, while medium and large farmers tend to have their own savings from previous harvests or access to loans from banks.

SECTION D

13. What are the advantages of India's land and sea boundaries?

Do you think India should have two time zones because of its wide east-west extent? Give reasons for your opinion.

Answer:

- 1. India shares land borders with **7 countries**, helping in **trade and cultural exchange**.
- 2. Long land borders make it possible to **connect by road and rail**.
- 3. The long coastline (7,516.6 km) helps India in importing and exporting goods.
- 4. The sea provides access to **foreign countries** for **tourism and trade**.
- 5. The coastline also supports **fishing and ship-building industries**.

Answer (Sample opinion):

Yes, India should have two time zones because:

- 1. The **time difference** between Gujarat and Arunachal Pradesh is **about 2 hours**.
- 2. In the northeast, the sun rises and sets much earlier, wasting **daylight hours**.
- 3. Two time zones would help in **better energy use**, productivity, and school/work timing.
- 4. Countries like the USA, Russia, and Canada have multiple time zones successfully.
- 5. However, it would need careful planning to avoid confusion in **travel and broadcasting**.

(Alternatively, a student could argue **against** it and support IST for **national unity** and **administrative ease**.)
