

- Line: A mark made by a moving point, creating a path or outline.
- **Shape:** A two-dimensional area defined by its outline, such as a circle or square.
- **Form:** A three-dimensional shape, like a sphere or cube.
- **Space:** The area within and around objects, including positive and negative space.
- Colour: The visual perception of light reflected by objects, including hue, saturation, and value.
- Value: The lightness or darkness of a colour.
- **Texture:** The surface quality of an object, whether real or implied.



Primary Colours- Red, Yellow & Yellow Secondary Colours-



- 1. Red + Yellow = Orange
- 2. Yellow + Blue = Green
- 3. Blue + Red = Violet

Tertiary Colours-

- 1. Red + Orange = Red Orange,
- 2. Red + Violet = Red Violet
- 3. Yellow + Green = Yellow Green
- 4. Yellow + Orange = Yellow-Orange
- 5. Blue + Green = Blue- Green
- 6. Blue + Violet = Blue- Violet
