Warm Colours- Violet, Red-Violet, Red, Red-Orange, Orange, Yellow-Orange, Yellow and Yellow-Green

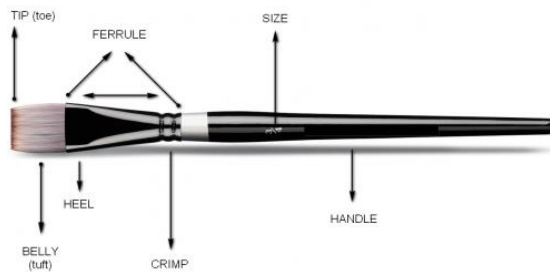

- **Shape:** A two-dimensional area defined by its outline, such as a circle or square.
- **Form:** A three-dimensional shape, like a sphere or cube.
- **Space:** The area within and around objects, including positive and negative space.
- **Colour:** The visual perception of light reflected by objects, including hue, saturation, and value.
- **Value:** The lightness or darkness of a colour.
- **Texture:** The surface quality of an object, whether real or implied.

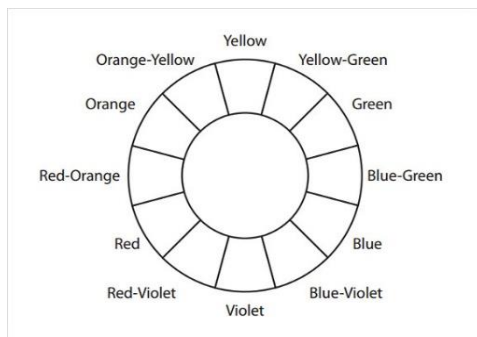

Primary Colours- Red, Yellow & Blue

Secondary Colours-

1. Red + Yellow = Orange
2. Yellow + Blue = Green
3. Blue + Red = Violet

Tertiary Colours-

1. Red + Orange = Red- Orange,
 2. Red + Violet = Red- Violet
 3. Yellow + Green = Yellow- Green
 4. Yellow + Orange = Yellow-Orange
 5. Blue + Green = Blue- Green
 6. Blue + Violet = Blue- Violet
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
