Ans- A Patwari is a local authority member who is responsible for the maintenance of land records and the administration of a village or group of villages. Their duties include:

I. Measuring land

Patwaris use various methods to measure agricultural fields, such as long chains. They compare their measurements to the map to ensure that the boundaries of the fields have not changed.

II. Keeping records

Patwaris maintain and update records of the village, including maps and other details.

III. Collecting land taxes

Patwaris organize the collection of land revenue from farmers.

IV. Providing information to the government

Patwaris provide the government with details about the crops grown in the area. This is based on the records they keep, which are important to update regularly.
