Moral: kindness is never wasted.

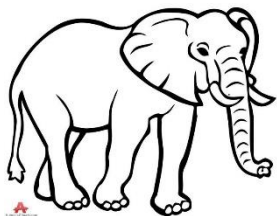

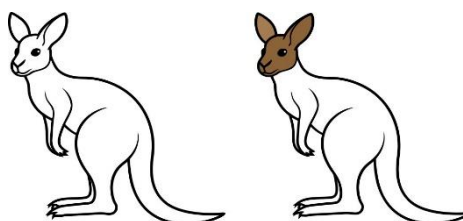

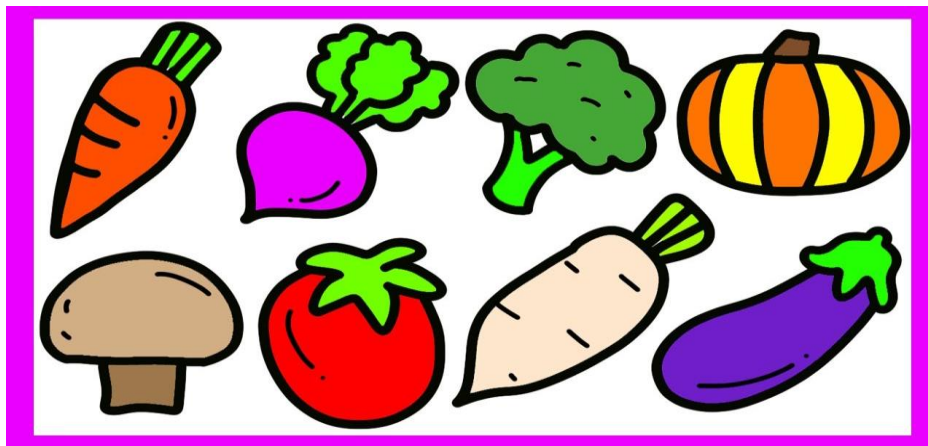
