Dear Parents, Academics and discipline are the cornerstones of a student's life as they provide the right knowledge and skill-sets for the students along with the qualities required for personal growth, career success, and contributing positively to society. Emphasizing the importance of academics and discipline in a student's life as crucial for their long-term well-being and development, the school has made certain rules for better coordination between parents, students and the management. The regulations are as follows:

- 1. <u>PARENTS' VISITS</u>: Parents can visit the school only on Sundays between 10.00 a.m. and 06.00 p.m. with prior written permission/ pre-appointment given via e-mail (subject to approval) by the Principal (maximum one visit bimonthly). Parents may be asked to wait during lunch breaks or if the concerned person is engaged with prior commitments. No visits will be allowed during the examination period.
- 2. <u>PARENTS' IDENTITY CARD</u>: Parents should carry their identity cards upon their visit on account of security reasons. Entry shall be subjected to identity card verification.
- 3. PARCELS/COURIERS/POST: Parents are requested to avoid sending Eatables and other non-essential items through couriers. Any necessary items (if not available in the school store) can be sent to your ward. Please remember to mention the student's name, class and admission number of the student on the respective packet/parcel. Letters and packets addressed to the students will be subjected to scrutiny by the School Authorities in the presence of the child. All correspondence regarding the same has to be addressed to the Principal. For any communication, please contact the schools help line numbers given in the circular. Timings for enquiries on telephone numbers mentioned below to be followed on all working days. However, in case of emergency, parents may call on other numbers given in the help-lines.
- 4. **FORBIDDEN ITEMS:** Gold Ornaments, Cash/ATM Cards/Credit Cards, Expensive/smart watches, Cameras, Electronic Gadgets and Smart Mobile Phones/SIM cards will not allowed to be kept by the students. Post Diwali break Henceforth only standard QRT mobile phones shall be used by the students, for communication as per the standard procedure for calling.

- **EATABLES**: Students are not allowed to keep eatables with them. Parents are advised not to give 5. eatables to be kept with the students, However, dry fruits can be given or any specific based on the doctor's advice
- BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION: Parents are not allowed to celebrate the birthday of their wards in the 6. school, however, they can apply for a special permission of meeting/ leave out on the respective day along with their parents/ guardian.
- **LEAVE OUTS/MEETINGS**: Parents are required not to apply for leave outs of their wards unless it is 7. mandatory. Parents may apply for normal leave out /meeting well in advance and shall come to the school only after obtaining permission for the same as per the given date and timings. Leave-outs will not be granted during the Examination period.
- Leave out without Escort: Leave out without escort is not permitted. However, in exceptional cases for 8. parents from distance stations or in case of emergencies, the school shall arrange for the same upon the parent's written request well in advance. Parents willing for leave out of their wards without escort need to submit an affidavit in this regard to the School Authorities.
- **Dropping at School**: Parents shall drop their wards at school on completion of leave between 8:00 AM 9. to 6:00 PM. Private vehicles will not be allowed beyond the Security Checkpoint near the Academic Block. Baggage is liable for search/scrutiny at the main gate upon the student's return. Your kind cooperation is solicited in this regard. Kindly avoid bringing prohibited items in the hostels. In the event of finding any forbidden items with the student, the item shall be seized and not be returned.

However, return of wards post Summer/Diwali Vacation will be at the hostel within the prescribed dates & timings scheduled by the school.

- 10. CASH: Students are not permitted to keep any cash with them. Parents are strictly advised not to give any cash at any time to their wards.
- School Fees; All the parents are requested to pay the next Quarter fees. Kindly adhere to the fee deposit 11. schedule given by the school. Defaulters may not be allowed to join back or attend the school till the time dues are not cleared.
- Any child in need of extra academic assistance may contact the Dean (Academics). The extra classes for 12. Manher the same will be arranged post-dinner without any charges.
